

BEE SAFE COMMUNITY PLEDGE SHEET

A BEE SAFE COMMUNITY IS A GROUP WHICH IS LESS THAN 75 HOUSEHOLDS, AND CAN INCLUDE CHURCHES, SCHOOLS, CO-HOUSING COMMUNITIES, HOA's, RETIREMENT COMMUNITIES, RURAL AREAS, ETC

As bees are endangered by the use of neonicotinoids and other systemic pesticides in the environment and we are aware of these dangers, we pledge to help in the efforts to limit or eradicate these poisons by adhering to the level or levels of care described below, as per Living Systems Institute and Bee Safe Boulder:

Level 1: We will not use any insecticide products that contain neonicotinoids or systemics.

Level 2: We will not use any products outdoors that contain poisons.

Level 3: We will plant plants that will provide bees with the nectar and pollen that they need for nourishment.

Note: Please include name of your entity or group, with buildings and grounds committee person's name and an administrative contact when appropriate. For co-housing communities, condos, or HOA's, we ask that all households pledge, unless all the grounds are maintained by a HOA board. If the grounds are completely maintained by the HOA board, then attach a copy of the resolution of the Board, pledging to become Bee Safe.
